Tom Kleese, professor of art and art history at UW-Richland: "How to Waste 6 Figures on a Perfectly Average Education". Between 11/06 and 11/07 Tom visited 52 colleges, most in the midwest. The sweet spot for college students to work is 15-20 hours/week. Goals for a college student: 1. be a better shopper, 2. college is my: job!, 3. maturation, 4. becoming a true adult while still in college. At the bare minimum: get a degree, speak effectively (no "like" or "um"), write well, even in email, think critically and logically. 39.5% get out in 4 years (UW-Madison). Average debt after undergrad: \$2,200-2,700. Average debt after graduate school: \$20,000.
