Work was projected on screen while the craftsmen worked. They use all hand tools - the only contemporary feature is climate control; hand crank wheel to operate lathe. Curtis Buchanan from Tennessee does one chair per week at \$1,000 per chair. John Alexander of Maryland wrote "Make a Chair from a Tree", working with green wood. Roy Underhill pulled a bottle of wine out of his work bench halfway through his presentation!
