**Program from 5/13/2008:** Bob Lavigna from the Partnership for Public Service. PPS works with federal government to inspire people to join the fed gov for their career. 56% children received federally funded lunches. Average # of new patents each day is 476. 190 million people travel fed-funded highways each day. Federal gov facing crisis in that 40% are age 50 or older, 429,000 employees are 55 or over; average age is 47; average new fed hire is 34. 530,000 fulltime, permanent employees will leave in next 5 years. Fed gov contracts 400 billion dollars/yr. in outsourcing. Big push now to outreach to colleges and universities to promote fed gov careers. Wide range of job opportunities. 2400 job classifications.
