DT Converter box convert digital back to analog. Digital does not mean better reception. Why is this happening? Government legislation in 2005 so no choice; analog will be for first responders. NTIA offering people \$40 coupon (2/household) to help defray cost of converter boxes. You can go to dtf2009.gov or dtvanswers.com. You can tell if your tv is analog or not by looking at plate on back of tv. If it says ATSC, you're digital. If it says NTSC, you're analog.
