Notes from last meeting, September 12, 2006: Barb Snell, CEO; Access Community Health Centers. Barb shared alarming statistics on health care. Having health insurance improves your life expectancy by 10-15%, improves your ability to earn a wage. Some people don't have tests done because they can't afford to pay for treatment. 5% of white in Dane Co. are uninsured; 26% of minorities are uninsured. #1 reason for elementary absences in Dane Co. is untreated dental pain. At Access, everyone pays something for their care. 58% of the budget comes from patient revenues and 42% comes from grants and the community. Access had 32,000 visits this year and predicts 60,000 in 2010!
