Better relationships with other clubs: go to other rotary meetings/invite other clubs to ours/share services (ex. Habitat House)

Service: Don N. handed out a tentative community service budget recommendation. Don's recommendations are to support Habitat for Humanity (\$3000.00), Henry Vilas Zoo (\$500.00), Salvation Army (\$500.00) and Falk School (\$1500.00).
